


Safety Cautions

Thanks for your purchasing of our projectors. Please read through this user manual and keep it properly after reading for future reference.

- Do not put the projector in the place where the warm air flows from the air conditions directly. Condensation of water or high temperature may lead to product damage.
- Please ensure no gather things around the projector and the vent is not blocked to avoid overheating.
- 3. Please prevent foreign objects such as nails or paper scraps from falling into the projector. Don't insert any metal objects such as iron wires or screwdrivers into the projector. If any foreign object falls into, please turn off the power immediately and ask professional technician to take it out.
- 4. Put the projector far away from the liquid to avoid damage by liquid leakage.
- 5. Please use soft packing material to protect the projector if any long-distance transport needed. In the meanwhile, prevent from violent crashes and shaking. Use cotton sheet with 75% medical alcohol to wipe the lens if any stains or finger prints on it.
- Do not look into the lens directly after the projector is turned on, the strong lights might hurt your eyes.
- Do not touch the front vent after a long time running, the vent may be heated and might burn your skin.



Please do not open the projector and conduct repair by yourself. If there is anything wrong, please contact with authorized customer service center for help.




Please do not locate the projector into the rain or heavy moist to avoid fire or electric leakage.









- Dust and dirt will block the air intake holes after a period of time using, a regular cleaning is required.
 According to the using environment differences, we recommand that the air intakes should be cleaned every 300 hours using.
- Cleaning method: swipe the air intakes gently with a soft brush unitl holes's dust and dirt removed.




Device Connectivity



Quick Guide

1. Projector Locating

Please put the projector on a top flat surface horizontally. Press power button to turn on the projector.



2. Turn ON/OFF

Turn ON


Touch (a) button on the top of projector or press (b) button on the remote control to turn on the projector.

Turn OFF

Touch **(**w) button twice on the top of projector or press **(**w) button twice on the remote control to shut down the system according to message presented.

3. Remote Operation and Pairing

Remote Operation




Remote Control Pairing

Press ① button of the remote control or enter into setting and select Remote & Accessories to go to pairing interface, then press and hold left and right buttons at the same time and don't release until indicating light starts to flash. It will start to process pairing




4. Focus Adjust



Press Focus+/Focus- buttons on the remote control to adjust the focus to make the image clear. Or turn on the Auto Focus in setting to enable auto focus feature, then it will adjust the focus automatically every time when any place or angle changed.

6. Wi-Fi Connection

Go to Setting interface to select details of Wi-Fi connections setting area. Or go to setting menu by pressing setting button on remote control, select network & internet to choose the Wi-Fi and connect it as you want.




7. Apps Download and Installation

go to Google Play store in the APPS interface and sign in your google account. Then select the app to download and install.



8. Bluetooth Connection

Go to Remote & Accessories in the setting, select Add accessory to search for Bluetooth devices and then choose right one for connection.



9. File Browser

Go to HilfileManager to select all kinds of files in internal or external USB memory devices to open and show on the screen such as audio, video or picture files.



10. Screen Mirroring

Open EshareSever in APPS, then follow the instructions show on the screen to realize screen mirroring. (This app is available for both IOS and Android devices)

Quick Settings

Auto Focus

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, select Auto Focus to enable auto focus feature to free your hands for imperceptible focus adjustment.





Auto Keystone (Horizontal & Vertical)

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, select Auto Keystone Correct to enable horizontal and vertical auto keystone feature to keep screen normal shape and at the best view angle for the audience.





Actuator Height


Go to the projector Setting in the setting, select Actuator Height, press the right or left of the remote control to control up or down of the projector.





Auto Obstacle Avoidance

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, select Auto Obstacle Avoidance to enable auto obstacle avoidance feature to avoid obstacles located in projection area automatically in order to keep the audience can always watch complete images.



Auto Rotation Correction

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, Auto Rotation Correction feature is enabled in default. In this case, the e-actuator will lift up to the right position when you hold the projector body for a few seconds, then it will project the image on the wall or screen in right shape and position you want.



Auto Position

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, Auto Position feature is enabled in default. In this case, the

e-actuator will lift up to the right position when you hold the projector body for a few seconds, then it will project the image on the wall or screen in right shape and position you want.



Brightness Mode

There are three brightness modes for this projector. You can go to Quick Settings to select the mode you want for different using scenarios.

• Bright Mode


Go to Quick Settings, in the setting, select Bright Mode to enable silent mode for higher brightness while watching.

• Silent Mode

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, select Silent Mode to enable silent mode for more quiet system running while watching at night.


Standard Mode

Standard mode is the default mode. Enable it by switching off both bright mode and silent mode.



Virtual Mouse

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, select Virtual Mouse to enable the remote control as mouse in order to reach some point of some apps for full operation.



Bluetooth Speaker Mode

Go to Quick Settings in the setting, select Bluetooth Speaker and choose OK to enter into Bluetooth Speaker mode when there is a popping box appear. Then find the projector Bluetooth name on your phone and tap it to pair to use the projector as a Bluetooth speaker. When the projector stays in Bluetooth speaker mode, projector will stop projection.



General Settings

Image Setting

Go to Projector Setting in the setting, select Image to adjust brightness, contrast, saturation, sharpness and color temperature.



Sound Setting

Go to Projector Setting in the setting, select Sound to adjust audio balance, bass, treble, equalizer and enable or disable surround sound effect.



Source Input

Select Inputs in the setting,or press **1** button on the remote then select HDMI as a signal source mode, press OK button on the remote control to switch input source from HDMI. And you can enable and disable Consumer electronic control feature such as HDMI Control(CEC/ARC), Device Auto power off, TV auto power on, Menu control for a better using experience when extra HDMI devices connected.



Auto Screen Alignment

Go to quick Setting in setting, Turn on the Auto Focus, When the projection distance of the projector is too large, the projected image will exceed the curtain. By Auto Screen Alignment, the image that originally exceeded the curtain can be zoomed into the curtain.



Projection mode

Go to Projector Setting in the setting, choose Projection Mode to select the right mode for the projector according to actual projection requirement.



Keystone Setting

Go to General Setting in the setting, choose Projector Setting, turn off auto focus, then you can see Vertical Correction and Horizontal Correction for you to adjust keystone on vertical or horizontal direction.



Rotate Correction

Go to General Setting in the setting, choose Projector Setting, turn off auto focus, then you can see Rotate Correction for you to adjust image angle to keep balance..




Screen Zoom

Go to General Setting in the setting, choose Projector Setting, turn off auto focus, then you can see Screen Zoom for you to adjust screen zoom in and zoom out.



Off-Axis Setting

Go to General Setting in the setting, choose Projector Setting, turn off auto focus, then you can see Vertical Off-Axis and Horizontal Off-Axis for you to adjust screen position on vertical or horizontal direction.



Four Point Keystone

Go to General Setting in the setting, choose Projector Setting, turn off auto focus, then you can see Four Point Keystone to adjust keystone manually.



Custom Calibration

Go to General Setting in the setting, choose Projector Setting, turn off auto focus, then you can find Custom Calibration to calibrate the image properly if image sharpness or shape abnormity happens. Follow the instructions on the screen to operate it during the calibration.



Language Setting

Go to System Preferences in the setting, select the language you want by pressing up and down buttons, then press OK buttons to confirm it.



Screen Saver

System Preferences in the setting, select Screen Saver then you can change the screen automation and when to start it.



Factory Restore


System Preferences in the setting, select Reset by pressing OK buttons to start factory restore. This operation will erase all data from the device's internal storage like google account, system and app data, settings and downloaded apps.

Cleaning Method

How to Clean

Please disconnect the power adapter before clean.

Please don't use insecticide or other volatile chemicals on projector or its lens.

Please don't let rubber or ethylene products contact the products for a long time. The coating will be damaged or peeled off.

Clean Projector

Please wipe with soft and dry cotton cloth. If it is very dirty, please wipe with a soft cloth dampened with diluted neutral detergent and use dry cloth to make it dry. If you use chemical fiber cloth, please be careful.

To avoid damage or coating peeled off, please don't use thinner, benzene or other solvents. Do not scratch the projector with nails or other hard objects to avoid scratching.

Clean Lens

Please use the professional cleaning kit such as air blower, lens cleaning tissue etc. to clean the lens. Or it may cause scratches.

Clean Ventilation Holes

Too many dusts will cause the projector overheating. Please clean ventilation holes at least every 1.000 hours use.

Turn off the projector>Disconnect the power adapter>Insert brush into a mini vacuum cleaner>Use it to clean outside of projector

Avoid direct use of vacuum cleaners without connectors, or use nozzles for cleaning.

Warm Hint: Due to the projector system might be updated Irregularly, so the operation maybe different, please refer to actual operations.
