

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Before using this projector, make sure you read all instructions. Nothing in this handbook should be altered or created.

- Keep the projector out of the rain and moisture to lower the risk of electric shock or fire. Vases and other items with liquid contents shouldn't be set on this apparatus.
- Avoid using this projector on flimsy surfaces like carpets or tablecloths as this could cause a fire.
- This device should not be placed next to any appliance that produces a strong magnetic field or in locations that are prone to heavy dust and debris.
- Do not obstruct or clog the ventilation apertures to avoid overheating.
- Never use this projector in a small area. Make sure there is always a dequate room for airflow around this item.
- Keep this projector away from excessive heat, dampness, extreme temperature swings, and direct sunshine. Steer clear of bitter cold. This device and its accessories should be stored and operated between 0°F and 95°F.
- The surface of this projector may get hot if it is used for an extended amount of time. Quickly turn it off and disconnect the charger. Once this device has cooled down, resume using it.
- Use caution whenever handling this equipment. Keep your hands off the lens. Children should never use a device without adult supervision.








OPERATION

 1. Match the Bluetooth remote control(requires extra AAA battery*2)





2. Select your region or country


Focus

Keystone Correction


- Press the setting button/display setting button - Image Correction

INSTALLATION


- Projected onto the ceiling
- 180° Adjustable Stand
- Just place it, tilt it and watch content come to life with the Google TV smart theater that makes it simple. The cradle stand gives you floor-to-ceiling flexibility with a rotation of 180 degrees-always giving you the best view



*Note: The stand cannot be forcibly rotated beyond 180 degrees, otherwise it may cause internal cables to be twisted, which may affect some functions unusable.

Tripod Mount/Ceiling Mount

- There are 6mm (1/4") screw hole at the bottom of the stand for installing Tripod Stand or Ceiling bracket.
