1 Safety Notice

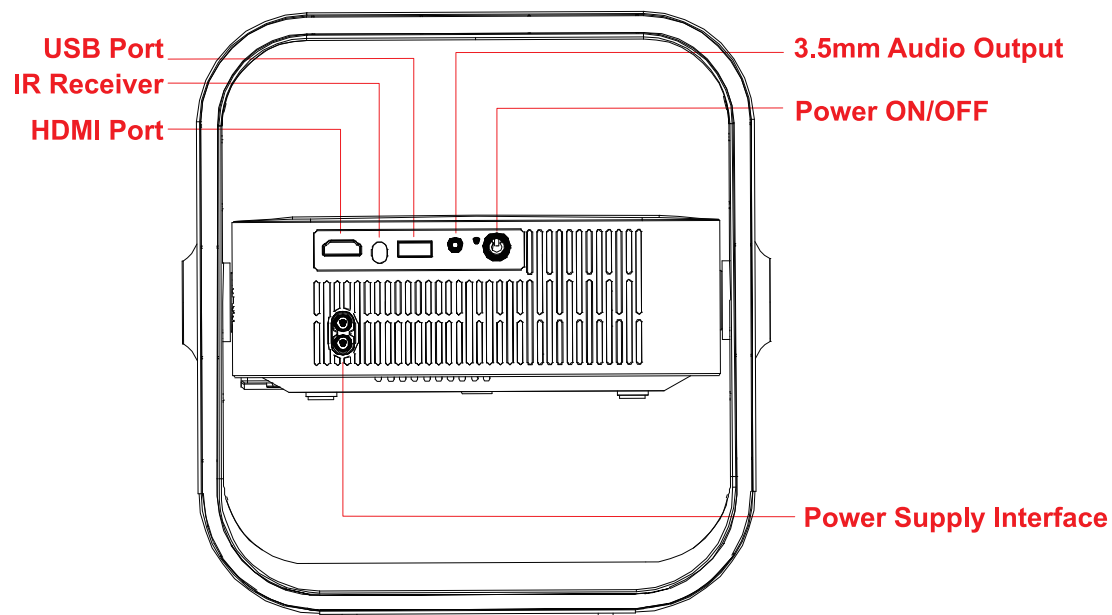
- 1.1 Please read this manual carefully before using the projector.
- 1.2 Use a stable, certified power supply (100-240V, 50/60Hz).
- 1.3 Always use the correct power cable supplied with the unit.
- 1.4 Do not disassemble or attempt to repair the projector yourself.
- 1.5 Avoid looking directly into the lens during operation.
- 1.6 Ensure proper ventilation and do not block air vents.
- 1.7 The projector is not waterproof; keep away from liquids.
- 1.8 Disconnect power if unused for a long period.
- 1.9 Avoid exposing the projector to heat, dust, or sunlight.
- 1.10 Keep out of reach of children and handle carefully.
- 1.11 The projector stand is fixed and not designed for removal.

Do not attempt to disassemble.



Ensure the remote has 2 x AAA batteries (not included)

2 Interface Overview



Power Supply Interface: Connect the supplied power cable

Power ON/OFF: Turn projector ON/OFF

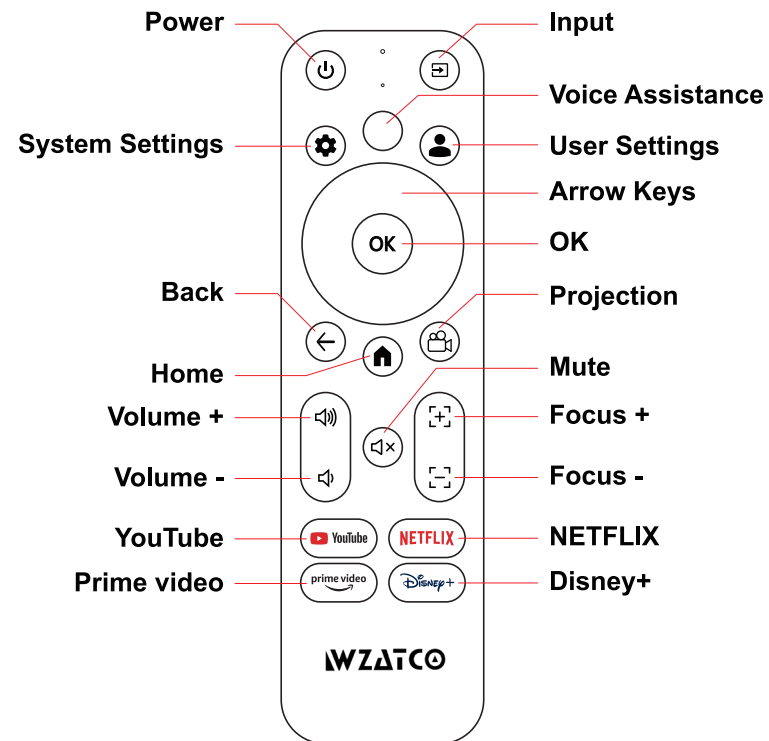
USB Port: For media playback from a USB drive

HDMI Port: For computers, consoles, or streaming devices

3.5mm Audio Output: For headphones or external speakers

IR Receiver: For remote control operation

3 Remote control



Power: Turn projector ON/OFF

Input: Switch between input sources

System Settings: Access system configuration menus

Voice Assistance: Activate voice control

User Settings: Manage personal preferences

Arrow Keys: Navigate through on-screen options

OK: Confirm selection

Back: Return to previous menu

Home: Return to main screen

Projection: Set mode to orient image

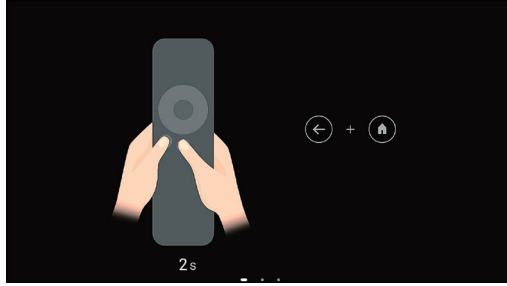
Volume: Adjust sound

Mute: Mute/Unmute

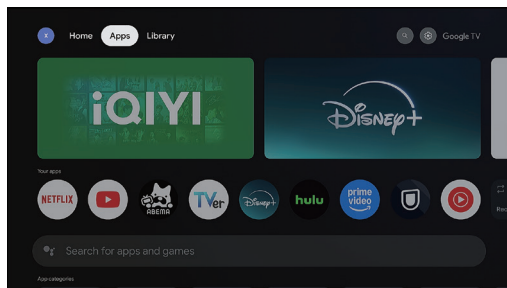
Focus: Adjust focus

4 Operation

- Plug the power cable to the projector, and press the power button to turn on
- Operate according to instructions
 1. Match the Bluetooth remote control (requires extra AAA battery*2)

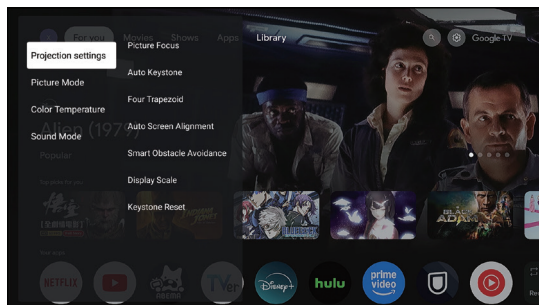
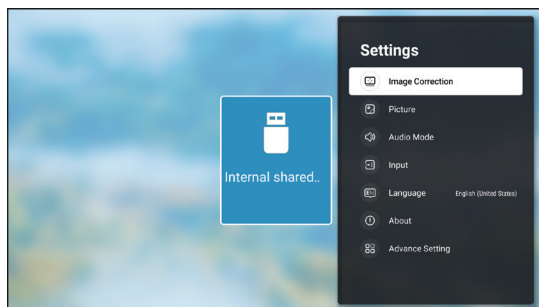


2. Select your region or country

4. Set up with your Google account and play your favorite content, or search and download your favorite Apps



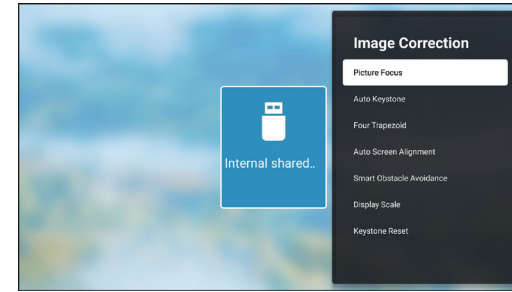
Focus

- Press the setting button/display setting button - Image Correction
- Set the Picture Focus until the image is clear.



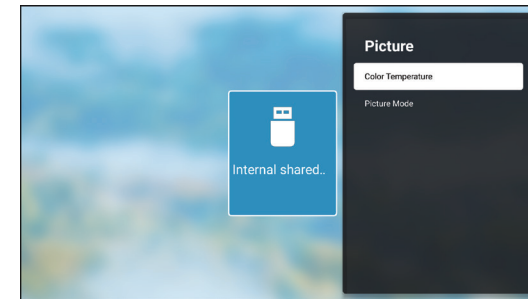
Keystone Correction

- Press the setting button/display setting button - Image Correction
- Set the Four Trapezoid until the image is square.



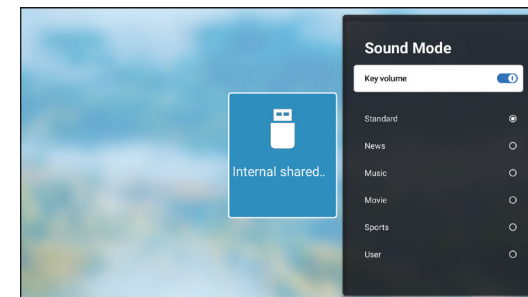
Picture

- Adjust the Color Temperature/Picture Mode according to your preference



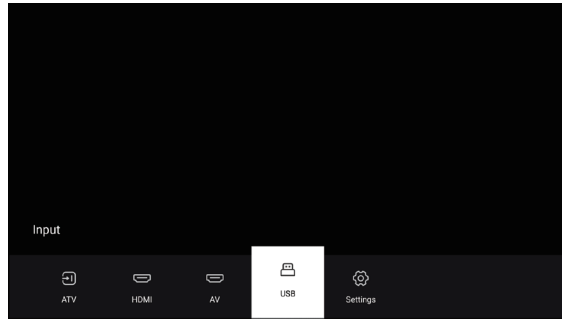
Audio Mode

- Adjust the Sound Mode according to your preference



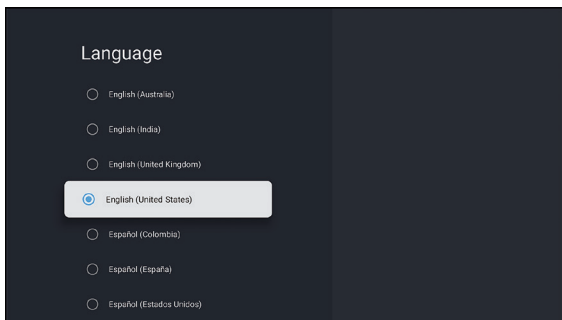
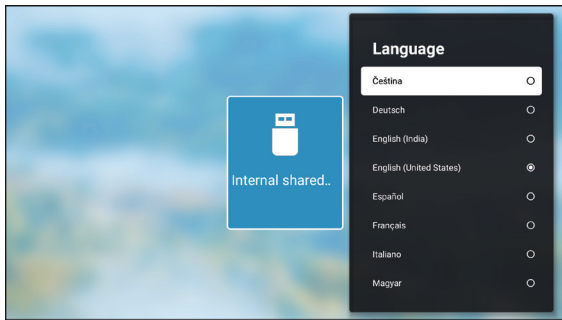

- Or • Press the setting button - Input - Source Setting



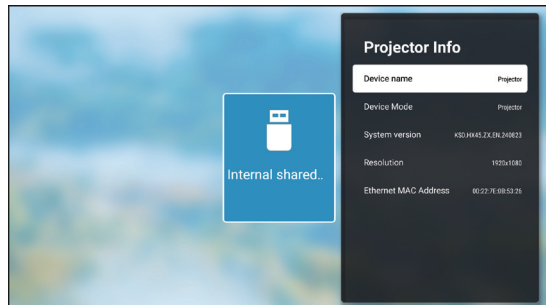

- Adjust the language according to your needs



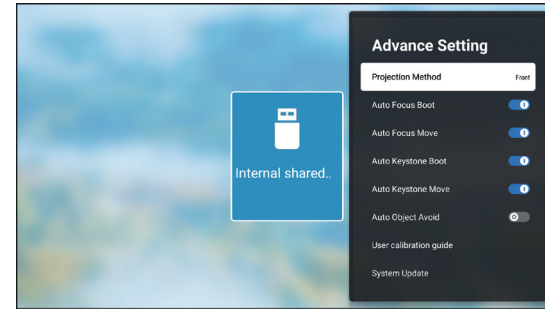

7 Trouble Shooting

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Loose cable or socket issue	Check and secure all power connections
No image	Wrong input selected	Select correct input(HDMI/USB)
Blurry image	Lens not focused	Use auto/electric focus by remote
No sound	Audio muted or disconnected	Increase volume or reconnect device
Image distorted	Incorrect keystone setting	Reset or adjust keystone
Remote not working	Dead or missing batteries	Replace both AAA batteries
Wi-Fi not connecting	Weak signal	Move closer to router
Bluetooth not paring	Device not in paring mode	Re-pair within 5m range
Overheating	Blocked ventilation	Turn off, clear vents and restart
USB not detected	Unsupported format	Reformat to FAT32 or NTFS
General system issue	Software error/corrupted settings	Perform a factory reset
