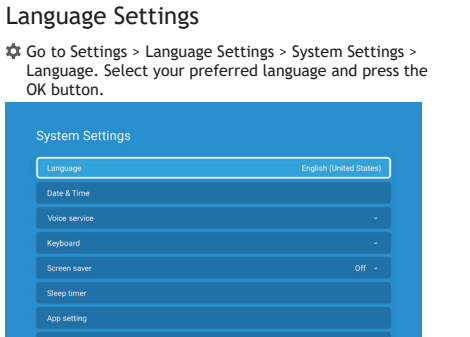
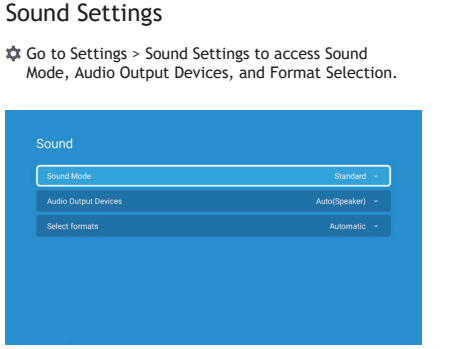
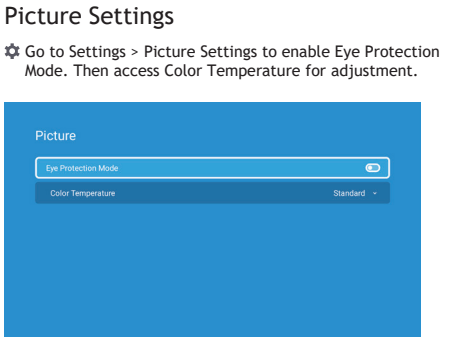
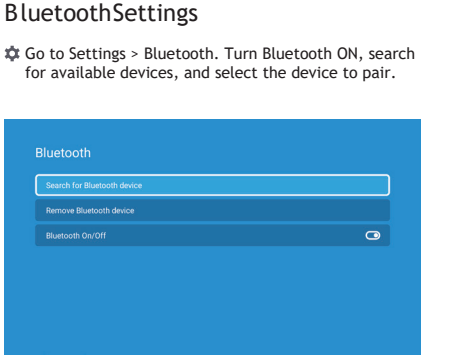
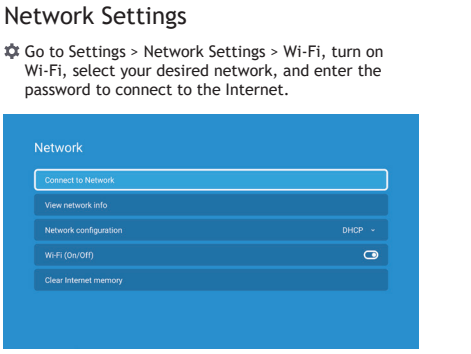
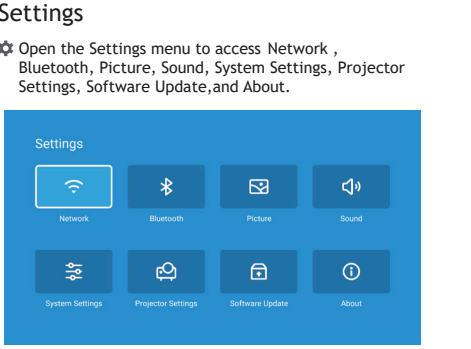
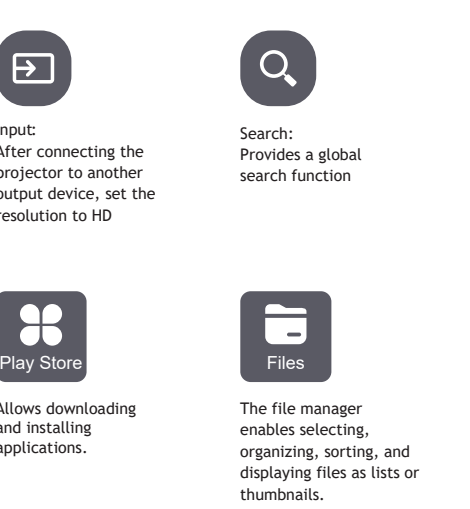
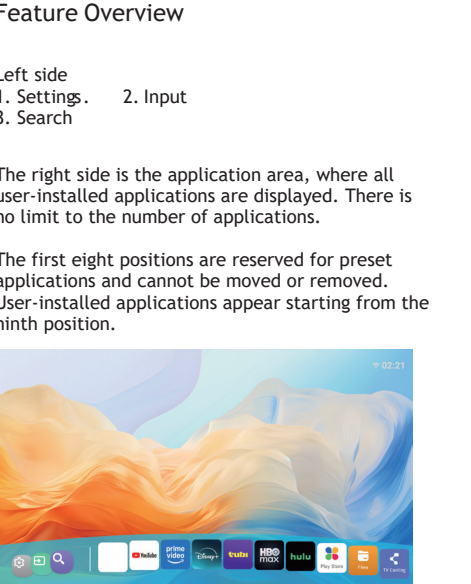
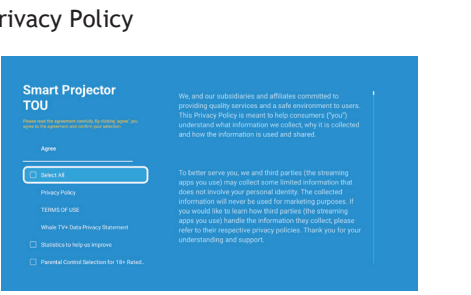
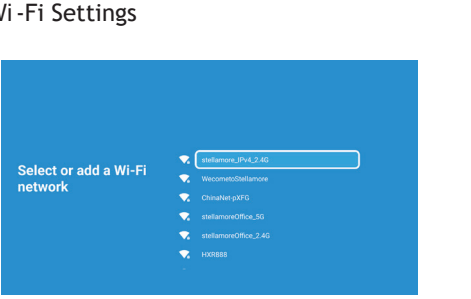
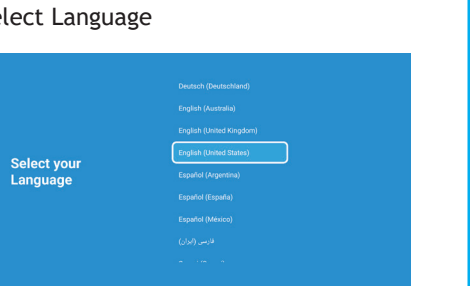
Attention

- 10. Do not attempt to disassemble the projector. Maintenance and repairs should only be performed by qualified personnel.

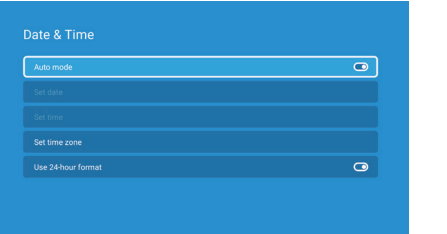


Note: When the Bluetooth remote pairing screen appears, press the "Voice" button to enter pairing mode.



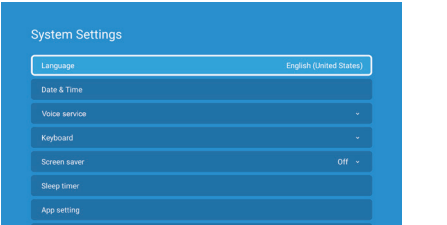
Date & Time Settings

- Go to Settings > Date & Time to access Auto Mode, Set Date, Set Time, Set Time Zone, and Use 24-Hour Format.



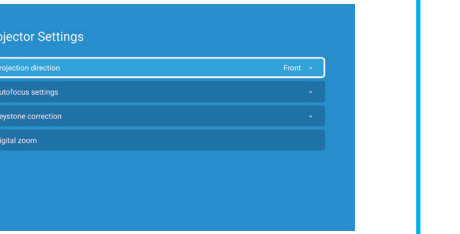
System Settings

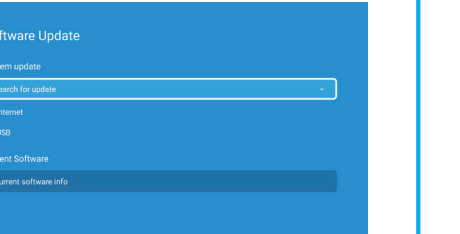
ProjectionSettings

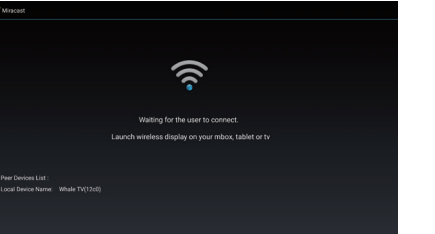

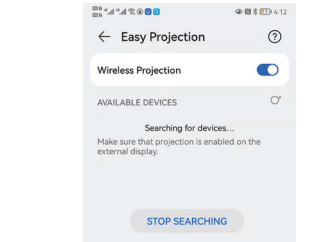


Mediacast Settings
